What is Flinders Aligned at The Heights School

Flinders Aligned provides students direct entry to approved Flinders University degrees through the study of a Certificate III in a relevant field. Flinders Aligned offers students:

- clear pathways from their school and VET to university
- confidence that their learning is recognised and valued
- multiple aligned options, not a singular pathway
- strong preparation for university study
- alignment with workforce and tertiary education needs

In considering a Flinders Aligned pathway, it is important to note:

- Students must still complete the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE)
- Some degrees may have additional entry requirements (such as pre-requisites, auditions, interviews, portfolios, etc.) This information should be accessed through Flinders University directly.
- Meeting the pathways requirements does not remove the need to meet course-specific conditions. Please refer to the THS course guides for pre-requisite and assumed knowledge.
- Explore eligible pathways through Flinders Aligned Pathways at THS agreement. This can be found in the VET section of our course handbook
- All students will be required to complete all compulsory SACE units, including EIF, AIF, Stage 1 English, Stage 1 Maths and complete a compulsory 200 Stage 1 and Stage 2 credits.
- Students may be required to choose elective subjects aligned with their pathway of choice

Flinders Aligned pathways begin in Year 10. To be eligible to study a Certificate III in Stage 1, students must meet all VET requirements. This includes:

- Work experience in a relevant field/industry
- Produce a portfolio of work (some courses)
- Complete and pass the Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment
- Complete a full application through the VET/Pathways Leader
- Be offered a placement through the VET/Pathways Leader

- VET Certificates must be endorsed through the Flexible Industry Pathways (FIPs). FIPs are aligned with South Australia's identified work shortages and align to the future planning of our State and National priorities.
